Attendance: As stated in the last newsletter, I would like to share some thoughts around Attendance.

Attendance at school is crucially important to your child's learning, confidence and sense of belonging. We value the partnership we have with you in helping your child to reach their potential. **Here are some important facts about attendance:**

- Our school monitors the attendance of all students on a daily basis. We record the reasons for absence and code them according to Ministry directives, for example illness, justified absence due to extenuating circumstances or explained but unjustified.
- Any student whose attendance drops below 90% is a deep concern to us. This works out at 10 days per year, or 2 and half days a term.
- We ask that unless your child is unwell or their attendance is impossible due to a
 family emergency or circumstances outside your control that you do your utmost to
 send your child to school. This is compliance with the law and means that your child
 can make the most of being at school.
- If you do not explain your child's absence, they are recorded as <u>truant</u>. Please contact the Attendance Office every time your child is not at school and let us know the reason.
- Persistent lateness is also an issue and we ask you to remind your student(s) to arrive at school before the first bell at 8:40am.
- There is a direct link between poor attendance and poor achievement.

Some examples of justified absence:

- Illness
- Funeral/Tangi
- Medical treatment offsite (for example a dentist visit)

Some examples of unjustified absence:

- having a day off for a birthday or any other reason
- family holidays
- going shopping

Attendance - What We Do:


- Text in the morning if we have not heard from you and your child is absent
- Code the absence (T = truant and will be the code if you do not tell us why your child is away)
- Form Teacher followup: phone call / text home
- Dean: Request a meeting if Truancy is concerning and ongoing
- Dean / SLT: Attendance meeting/hui around barriers to attendance OR a home visit
- After a period of unjustified absence we may send our Home Liaison officer for a visit to try and determine the reason for the absence
- Make an attendance service referral to the truancy officer if the issue is not resolved. This is so that the school is compliant with the law.

What we need from you:

- Send your child to school, keeping them home only if they are sick or you have a
 genuine family emergency. Also make sure they are at school on time. Vital learning can be
 missed when your children are late
- Contact the attendance office if your child is unable to attend school, and explain the reason. The school will text you if there has been no contact prior to 9:15am.
- If for any reason you need to take your child from school during school hours, notify the Attendance Office
- Where possible, make appointments outside of school hours.
