**Ongoing Strike Action:** Thank you to our school community for your understanding around the recent strikes. While the strike action is as much to do with working conditions as pay, it is evident other countries clearly value their teachers more and this is reflected in the remuneration of teachers in other countries:

NZ 61,329 - 103,086

AUS 96,713 - 161,312

UK 90,011 - 139,560

Retention of teachers is just as important as recruitment, we have so many young teachers abandoning the profession and heading off shore (about 20% attrition in the first 5 years). While we had hoped this industrial action would be sorted quickly, it appears this is not going to be the case.
